2024 FINAL REPORT OF TOTAL GHG EMISSIONS FROM DAIRIES AND FEEDLOTS FOR 2023

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Tulare County Board of Supervisors will hold a public hearing on Tuesday, May 6, 2025, at 9:30 a.m., or as soon thereafter as it can be heard, in the Chambers of the Board of Supervisors, Administration Building, County Civic Center, 2800 West Burrel, Visalia, California.

The hearing pertains to a Common Sense Exemption and a Categorical Exemption for the 2024 Final Report of total GHG emissions from dairies and feedlots for 2023 ("2024 Final Report"). The purpose of the hearing is to receive a presentation to consider the 2024 Final Report and provide an opportunity for public comment.

The appropriate environmental determination is an exemption for the 2024 Final Report of total GHG emissions from dairies and feedlots for 2023, consistent with the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and the CEQA Guidelines pursuant to Title 14, Cal. Code of Regulations Section 15061(b)(3), pertaining to the common sense exemption because CEQA only applies to projects which have to potential for causing a significant effect on the environment and Section 15306, Class 6, pertaining to basic data collection, research, experimental management, and resource evaluation activities which do not result in a serious or major disturbance to an environmental resource.
