NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Tulare County Board of Supervisors will hold a public hearing on May 6, 2025 at 9:30 a.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter can be heard, in the Chambers of the Board of Supervisors, located at 2800 West Burrell, Visalia, California.

The hearing will pertain to allocating Southern California Edison (SCE) work credit funds towards the establishment of an Underground Utility District in conjunction with the SCE "Rule 20 A" Program and undergrounding approximately 4,000 feet of SCE above ground Distribution and Transmission conductors, as well as third party overhead communication cables, with proposed wires and inside the proposed construction limits along Road 204 north of Avenue 256 to 2,000 feet south of Avenue 256 west of the Community of Tonyville and north of the City of Lindsay.

The Environmental Assessment Officer has found that this activity is exempt from review under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and the State CEQA Guidelines as a replacement and reconstruction (undergrounding) of existing utility systems (transmission lines on power poles) pursuant to Class 2 CCR 15302 (d) Replacement or Reconstruction.
