SUBJECT: Approve a Sublicense Agreement with the Tulare County Office of Education and Stone Corral Elementary

REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Approve a Sublicense Agreement with the Tulare County Office of Education and Stone Corral Elementary for the use of ActVnet, retroactive from November 20, 2024 through June 30, 2029. The Sublicense Agreement is retroactive because there was a delay in negotiating and finalizing the agreement, making it impracticable for the Board to take action prior to November 20, 2024.
2. Find that the Board had the authority to enter into the proposed agreement as of November 20, 2024, and that it was in the County's best interest to enter into the agreement on that date;
3. Authorize the Sheriff, or designee, to sign the Sublicense Agreement with the Tulare County Office of Education and Stone Corral Elementary.
4. Direct the Sheriff's Office to provide a copy of the executed agreement to the Clerk of the Board.

SUMMARY:

ActVnet is a digital software application developed by Tulare County Office of Education (TCOE) as a tool to assist safety agencies like the Tulare County Sheriff's Office (TCSO), in responding to emergencies on the district campus.

The Program provides designated law enforcement access to a school's cameras, site plans, classroom photos, and other pertinent data in the event of an emergency. TCOE has entered into Software User Agreements with each of the participating school

districts. TCSO is now proposing to enter into software sublicense agreements with TCOE and each of the participating districts.

Under the Sublicense Agreement, TCSO will have access to certain school and district information including, but not limited to school site floor plans, staff photographs and identification information, drone photography of specific campus locations, and video surveillance of specific campus locations, where such access would assist TCSO in responding to immediate and serious threats to safety on campus.

The following terms and conditions in the Sublicense Agreement deviate substantively from the County's standard boilerplate:

- 1) The Sublicense Agreement contains a mutual indemnification provision that makes each party responsible for the actions of its employees and agents.
- 2) The Sublicense Agreement can be terminated by any party with thirty days' written notice and will automatically terminate if the school district's Software User Agreement with TCOE is terminated or expires.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

The Agreement has no financial implications on the Sheriff's operating budget. There is no net County cost associated with the Agreement and it does not have impact on the General Fund.

LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:

The County's five-year strategic plan includes the Safety and Security Initiative. The purpose of this initiative is to provide safety and security to the general public. TCOE in collaboration with TCSO will provide various resources and support to ensure the safety and well-being of students and adults on school campuses and within the community.
