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1. Approved the Right-of-Way Contract with Gregory R. Cahill and Sandra S. Cahill in the amount of \$67,300 as part of the Avenue 280 Widening Project - Segment 2, between Lovers Lane and Virginia Avenue, near the Cities of Visalia and Farmersville.
2. Authorized the Resource Management Agency Director, or his/her designee, to sign the Contract and all documents needed to facilitate the related right-of-way acquisition.
3. Directed the Resource Management Agency Director, or his/her designee, to provide a signed copy of the Contract to the Clerk of the Board, with all other related documents to be maintained by the Resource Management Agency.
4. Directed the Auditor to draw warrants in favor of the County's designated escrow company for the contract amount, plus escrow fees estimated at \$2,051.
