**SUBJECT:** Approve Budget Adjustment

### **REQUEST(S):**

That the Board of Supervisors:

Approve the budget adjustment in the amount of \$173,400 resulting from an award from the Irvine Foundation to evaluate and address barriers to accessibility within the local workforce development system (4/5ths vote required).

### **SUMMARY:**

The Workforce Investment Board of Tulare County (WIB), a California nonprofit corporation, is designated by the Tulare County Board of Supervisors as the local workforce development board to provide policy guidance and oversight of workforce development services within Tulare County, as required by the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act of 2014 (WIOA).

The WIB and the County renewed an Administrative Services Agreement (#28274) in August of 2017 to provide the administrative framework under which the WIB and County shall cooperate in undertaking workforce development programs within the County of Tulare. The agreement intends for the WIB to continue to be invested with substantial independent authority for the design, development, administration, and operation of the workforce system in the county.

The Irvine Foundation project goal strives to ensure that all residents of Tulare County have the awareness, ability, and knowledge to receive training, employment, and other services offered by our Employment Connection system. The total award amount is \$250,000, and the remaining \$76,600 of funding will be budgeted in FY 2026.
