SUBJECT: Approve and Agreement with the California Department of Food and Agriculture

REQUEST(S):
That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Approve an Agreement with the California Department of Food and Agriculture in the amount not to exceed \$12,075 for the Fuels, Lubricants and Automotive Products Program effective July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022.
2. Authorize the Chair of the Board to sign the Agreement.

SUMMARY:

This Agreement is intended to subvent costs incurred by the County for inspections and sampling relating to the advertising and labeling of petroleum and automotive products at establishments selling or distributing petroleum and/or automotive products. This Agreement will allow for the continuation of this long-standing program during fiscal year 2021/22.

The Agreement has been approved to form by County Counsel. The following terms deviate from the County boilerplate:

Mutual Liability – parties agree to be liable for their own wrongful or negligent action, neither party indemnifies the other.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

There will be no net county cost in performing this service. The County will receive \$12,075 for the FY 21/22 if this Agreement is approved.
