**SUBJECT:** Delta Vector Control District Assessment Ballots 2021-22

**REQUEST(S):**

That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Approve authority to vote on the Delta Vector Control Assessments.
2. Direct General Services Agency Director or their designee to mark ballot on the affirmative on the proposed Assessments.
3. Direct General Services Agency Director or their designee to submit the ballots by July 21, 2021.

**SUMMARY:**

The County of Tulare has received the Official Notice and Assessment Ballot Information Guide for the Proposed Improved Mosquito, Vector and Disease Testing and Control Assessment from the Delta Vector Control District for parcels owned by the County of Tulare. The attached Exhibit A lists the Tulare County parcels, proposed assessment, and description of each. The Delta Vector Control District intends to increase costs to continue and improve year-round control of invasive mosquitoes and the diseases they carry.

This assessment will continue as long as the Delta Vector Control District Board of Trustees approves an annual resolution for continuation. After Fiscal Year 2021-22, the assessment can only be increased due to inflation that is equal to the change in the Western Region's Pacific Division Consumer Price Index (CPI) for all Urban consumers. This will occur in December of each succeeding year not to exceed 3% per year. The annual adjustments must be reviewed and approved annually at a public meeting.

**SUBJECT:** Delta Vector Control District Assessment Ballots 2021-22

**DATE:** June 29, 2021

**FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:**

Should the proposed assessment be approved by voters in the Delta Vector Control District assessment area, an estimated combined total annual assessment of \$2,046.41 will be incurred by County owned properties listed in Exhibit A for year 2021-22. Subsequent assessment years have the potential to increase up to 3% by the annual CPI. There is no Net Cost to the General Fund.

**LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:**

The County's Strategic Business Plan includes the Quality of Life initiative to promote natural resource management. Approval of this Assessment will improve year-round control of invasive mosquitoes and the diseases they carry
