**SUBJECT:** Approve an Agreement with the City of Lindsay

**REQUEST(S):**

That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Approve an agreement between the Tulare County Sheriff's Office and the City of Lindsay to provide emergency dispatch services to the City of Lindsay Department of Public Safety in an amount not to exceed \$83,312, for the period of July 1, 2021 to June 30, 2022; and
2. Authorize the Chair of the Board to sign the Agreement.

**SUMMARY:**

The Tulare County Sheriff's Office (TCSO) has been providing emergency dispatch services to the City of Lindsay (CITY) Department of Public Safety for several years due to the CITY not having a dedicated emergency dispatch center. CITY is requesting that TCSO continue to provide emergency dispatch services and enter into an agreement for TCSO to provide the CITY with emergency dispatch services twenty-four hours per day/seven days per week. TCSO emergency dispatchers will answer, monitor and respond to all emergency calls for the CITY to aid in the safety and security of the community. Dispatchers will alert appropriate personnel and dispatch any additional personnel and/or equipment when necessary. It is estimated that TCSO will dispatch approximately 10,472 calls for service for the CITY during this contract period.

The following terms deviate substantively from the standard County boilerplate: The Agreement contains a mutual indemnity provision.

**SUBJECT:** Approve an Agreement with the City of Lindsay

**DATE:** June 29, 2021

**FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:**

The agreement with the CITY is in an amount not to exceed \$83,312, for the period of July 1, 2021 to June 30, 2022. TCSO based cost for services on an analysis of dispatched calls for the CITY over the last five years. Reimbursement funds for TCSO dispatch services will be included in the Sheriff's Fiscal Year 2021/22 operating budget. There is no additional net County cost to the General Fund.

**LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:**

The agreement with the CITY aligns with the Strategic Business Plan initiative of providing for the safety and security of the public by providing emergency dispatch services to the CITY.
