SUBJECT: Ratify Orders Issued Pursuant to Local Emergency

REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

Ratify all Orders issued by the Emergency Services Director, or successor, between April 11, 2023 and May 1, 2023, pursuant to the Local Emergency proclaimed on March 9, 2023.

SUMMARY:

On March 9, 2023, a severe winter / atmospheric river storm began impacting Tulare County, prompting a Proclamation of Local Emergency by the Director of Emergency Services. As a result of this storm, significant flooding has been experienced throughout the County, requiring numerous evacuation warnings and orders across the valley, foothill, and mountain regions of Tulare County.

These orders, including lifting or modifications thereof, were issued pursuant to Part 1, Chapter 15 of Tulare County Ordinance Code, and must be ratified by the Board of Supervisors at the next practicable opportunity. Staff therefore requests that the Board of Supervisors ratify all orders related to evacuations to date for this incident. Additional ratification items will be presented as necessary to ratify additional orders on or after today's date.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

There is no cost associated with issuing, rescinding, or ratifying orders related to evacuations.
