**SUBJECT:** Receive a presentation on efforts addressing homelessness

**REQUEST(S):**

That the Board of Supervisors:

Receive a presentation on efforts addressing homelessness, including updates on the Task Force on Homeless, the Homeless Multidisciplinary Team, and related funding.

**SUMMARY:**

On December 20, 2016, the Tulare County Board of Supervisors (BOS) adopted Resolution No. 2016-1046, forming the Tulare County Task Force on Homelessness. Since that time, the landscape of homelessness has significantly changed with explosive growth in the number of unhoused individuals, new policies and laws impacting efforts, and unprecedented levels of funding. During the pandemic, the Tulare County Health & Human Services Agency (HHSA) formed the Homeless Multidisciplinary Team (Homeless MDT) to help enhance our street outreach efforts and collaboration with community partners.

This presentation will provide an update to the BOS on the activities of the Homeless Task Force, HHSA's Homeless MDT, and funding applied to help in building the future in our community.

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**LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:**
