SUBJECT: Approve an amendment to Agreement No. 30520 with Altura Centers for Health

REQUEST(S):

That the Board of Supervisors:

1. Approve an amendment to Agreement No. 30520 with Altura Centers for Health to provide core sexually transmitted disease surveillance and disease intervention, in an amount not to exceed \$264,312 to replace and supersede Exhibit B to reflect the \$44,156 increase to the budget, effective May 7, 2024, through June 30, 2024.
2. Authorize the Chair of the Board to sign the amendment.

SUMMARY:

The Tulare County Board of Supervisors (BOS) approved Agreement No. 29951 on November 17, 2020, with the California Department of Public Health (CDPH) for the STD Program Management and Collaboration Project for the implementation of public health activities to monitor, investigate, and prevent STDs in collaboration with community-based organizations with the local health jurisdiction. Tulare County's annual award is \$172,685, but it received an additional \$176,626 in funding per year for Fiscal Year 2022/2023 and Fiscal Year 2023/2024. No less than 50% of the funds shall be provided to one or more community-based organizations for purposes consistent with Health and Safety Code Section 120511.

On January 25, 2022, the BOS approved Agreement No. 30520 with Altura Centers for Health to provide STD Collaboration services and activities to include but is not limited to voluntary screening for STDs among justice-involved youth and adults; technology,

telehealth, and digital platforms and applications to enhance immediate access to screening, testing, and treatment; state-of-the-art testing modalities that ensure swift and accurate screening for and diagnosis of, STDs, and community-based testing and disease investigation.

Due to an increased allocation from CDPH, the funding to Altura Centers for Health is being increased by \$44,156 to meet the grant's 50% minimum funding requirement for community-based organizations.

FISCAL IMPACT/FINANCING:

The budgeted costs associated with this amendment are included in the HHSA budget 001-142-6064-7043 for Fiscal Year 2023/2024. It will increase the allocation associated with this agreement by \$44,156. The total cost of this agreement will increase from \$220,156 to an amount not to exceed \$264,312. Fiscal Year 2023/2024 will increase to \$87,238. This agreement is funded by the California Department of Public Health, STD Program Management and Collaboration Project grant. There is no net County cost to the General Fund.

LINKAGE TO THE COUNTY OF TULARE STRATEGIC BUSINESS PLAN:

This amendment increases our ability to meet the County's five-year strategic plan, specifically the Quality-of-Life Initiative that encourages innovative provision of the quality supportive services for at-risk adults, youth, and children in state and federally-mandated programs. This program assists those in our community who have no other source of care and are in the at-risk category by linking them to services and providing non-medical case management.

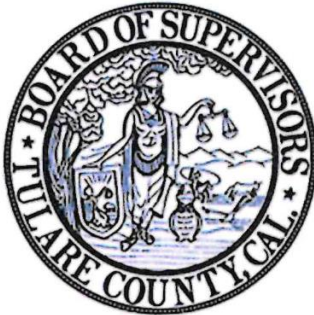

**FIRST AMENDMENT TO
TULARE COUNTY AGREEMENT NO. 30520**

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT ("Amendment") to Tulare County Agreement Number 30520 (the "Agreement") is entered into by and between the **COUNTY OF TULARE** ("COUNTY") and **ALTURA CENTERS FOR HEALTH**, a ("CONTRACTOR"), a non-profit corporation as of May 7, 2024, with reference to the following:

- A. The COUNTY and CONTRACTOR entered into the Agreement on January 25, 2022, to provide core sexually transmitted diseases surveillance and disease intervention.
- B. COUNTY and CONTRACTOR now wish to amend the Agreement to increase the total budgeted amount for Fiscal Year 2023/2024 from r \$220,156 to an amount not to exceed \$264,312 and replace and supersede Exhibit B to reflect the increased \$44,156 amount.

ACCORDINGLY, COUNTY and CONTRACTOR agree as follows:

1. This First Amendment becomes effective upon Board signature.
2. Exhibit B, "Compensation Amount" is replaced and superseded by the attached Exhibit B, reflecting the above-increased contract amounts for Fiscal Year 2023/2024.
3. Except as provided above, all other terms and conditions of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.

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




